Saturday Only attendance (includes all meals but NO overnight lodging):

- o Ages 4-7: \$8
- o Ages 8-14: \$12
- o Ages 15-Adult: \$20

Weekend Schedule, What to Bring & Camp Rules

Abbreviated Weekend Schedule:

Friday Night

8:30 PM – Registration begins in the Dining Hall, along with fellowship and snacks.

Saturday – meals, morning and afternoon assemblies, free time (fishing, boating, hiking, etc.), Vespers, HOE DOWN, "hayless" hayride, snacks ****the HOE DOWN will be in place of the Talent Show this retreat****

Sunday - breakfast, cabin & camp clean-up, Worship, and Closing Circle.

Our retreat will be concluding with the Closing Circle after Worship on Sunday. We will no longer be serving Sunday lunch so you can be home in time to enjoy the holiday with your families.

- ALL YOUTH **16 and under** **MUST** be accompanied by an adult (over 21) in a boat, and wear a life jacket.
