DRESS CODE: We are a Christian Camp and have explicit expectations regarding the dress of our youth and adults at camp. Our faith leads us in our daily walk and decision making. Our faith also speaks to us of being in the world and not of the world. We understand this to apply to the clothing that we wear. Even with constantly changing fashions, we can dress in the spirit of modesty and be respectful of ourselves and those around us.

<u>Shoes</u> – tennis shoes, sandals, and flip-flops are appropriate, although shoes MUST be worn at all times (except inside the fenced pool area).

FEMALES:

<u>Shirts</u> - refrain from anything low-cut, or with bare shoulders, bare back, and/or stomach. Sleeveless shirts, including tank tops, are permitted, as long as the shoulder strap is at least two fingers wide. (No spaghetti straps.) Appropriate undergarments should be worn. Undergarments should not be visible.

Clothing promoting sex, drugs, tobacco, alcohol or violence is considered inappropriate.

<u>Shorts, skirts, dresses</u> - Shorts, dresses and skirts must and be of an appropriate length to actively participate in all camp activities. Shorts must be no shorter than a four inch (4") inseam. Shorts and pants must be secured and worn around waist. Underwear may not show.

<u>Bathing suits</u> - can be 2-piece but should be modest and worn only at the pool. (No string bikinis.) Appropriate cover should be worn to and from the pool. (A towel is not appropriate cover.)

<u>Dress-up outfits for Banquet</u> – There is one dress-up occasion during Camp, though formal dress is not mandatory. Casual dresses, skirts, blouses, and pants are permitted. Prom dresses will be permitted, understanding that many of them are bare-shouldered or spaghetti-strapped. Please do not bring them if they are too low-cut, revealing and/or have midriff showing. Other dresses should not be too tight and/or too short (at least to mid-thigh).

At all times, we reserve the right to ask a camper to change clothing.

MALES:

<u>Shirts</u> – shall be worn at all times on the Camp property (except in the pool). Sleeved t-shirts, polo shirts, dress shirts are all appropriate. Tank tops or sleeveless t-shirts will be permitted only during free time. No cut-offs.

Clothing promoting sex, drugs, tobacco, alcohol or violence is considered inappropriate.

<u>Shorts</u> - must be modest and extend at least to middle of the thigh. Shorts and pants must be secured and worn around waist. Underwear may not show.

<u>Bathing suits</u> – swimming trunks (no speedo-style suits). Appropriate cover should be worn to and from the pool. (A towel is not appropriate cover.)

<u>Dress-up outfits for Banquet</u> – There is one dress-up occasion during Camp, though formal dress is not mandatory. Pants, dress shirts (with or without a tie) or polo shirts are appropriate.

At all times, we reserve the right to ask a camper to change clothing.
